- Call Meeting** Meeting called by President Leo Corona at 6:07 PM
- Attendance** Leo Corona, Scott Rosenlof, Chris Guerrero, Jill Caldwell, Cristina Solomon, Paige Smith, Gina Luna, Sandra Skidmore, Ed Cora, Ms. Rodgers (teacher rep.)
- Previous Minutes** Minutes from February 11, 2010 meeting presented by Jill Caldwell. Motion made by Cristina to accept as presented, 2nd by Paige. Motion approved.
- Treasurer Report** Treasurer report presented by Cristina Solomon. PTSC balance as of March 2, 2010 is \$9,199.15. We are \$6,259 from our basic fundraising goal of \$15,458. Motion made by Paige to accept as presented, 2nd by Sandra. Motion approved.
- New Business** Silent Auction/King and Queen Luau Raffle Donations – Costco and Target have tentatively pledged to donate gift cards. Julie will help us put out letters requesting donations from parents and businesses. We will make additional plans for these events at our next meeting.
- “Insiders” Thank you Letters – The 47 “Insiders” students wrote letters to PTSC thanking us for paying the admission cost for their recent fieldtrip to the Santa Barbara Zoo. The board enjoyed reading and sharing the very nice sentiments of the grateful students.
- Committee Report** Boosters Basketball Snack Bar – Paige reported \$117 income from the March 3rd games. Total income to date for both 7th and 8th grade seasons is approximately \$760 (includes \$165 petty cash that will be deposited with income from the last game), three more games remain.
- Old Business** Tri-tip BBQ Sandwich Fundraiser – Saturday March 27, 2010, 11:00 AM – 2:00 PM. As of March 4, 2010, tickets checked out are 131, with 17 paid. Mr. Cora will put out a Connect-ed message tomorrow encouraging parents to purchase tickets.
- Committee meeting – Held February 18, went well.
- Donations – Scott has someone who may donate the ½ cord of red oak needed. Also, Ms. Lefever has a friend donating wood. Leo has contacted several businesses asking for food donations, and Paige is asking Roberta at FoodMaxx to help us with requests from Coca-Cola and Frito Lays.
- Student Volunteers – Mr. Cora will arrange scheduling for “Insiders” students – 8 students per hour, beginning to arrive at 10:00 AM, with all students being picked-up by 2:15 PM.
- Incentives – Students selling 10 or more tickets will receive a Subway sandwich party. Homeroom contests to be for 1 class with the highest participation rate and 2 classes with the highest sales. The 3 winning homerooms will be given a choice of either a Pizza or Rootbeer float party.
- Civil War Re-Enactment / Band and Choir Concert BBQ Fundraiser – *(PTSC will be preparing six tri-tip sandwich meals to feed the Civil War Re-enactment crew.)*
- 150 BBQ hamburger meals, including a burger, chips, and soda, will be prepared for sale to the public for \$5.00 each, water and soda may be purchased separately. Serving time will be 5:30 to 6:30 PM. Band and Choir concert to begin at 6:30 PM.
- PTSC Bylaws Review, Suggestions, and Comments – All board members expressed great appreciation for the excellent work put forth by Parliamentarians Sandra Skidmore and Jennifer Ellsworth. Suggestions were made about membership and meeting date clauses. A discussion was held involving funds permitted to be deposited into the PTSC account, and requirements for sub accounts to provide budget information to PTSC for approval. The bylaws are anticipated to be approved and signed at our final meeting and will take effect next year.
- Coffee Trailer for Parent Night Fundraising – Good Neighbor Bakery was contacted, they have not done fundraising and will consider the idea. Owner will call back next week.

PTSC was previously considering free Luau Dance entry to students selling a minimum number of tickets.
