**Notice to Contractors Calling for Bids, Page 4, Forth paragraph, change to read as follows:**

All Bidders shall be licensed under the provisions of Chapter 9, Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California to do the type of work contemplated in the Project. The successful bidder shall possess a valid Contractor's License issued by the Contractor's State License Board at the time the contract is awarded. The class of license shall be C-27 Landscaping Contractor, **D-49 Tree Service** or any other classification applicable to the work specified in the contract. Each bidder shall also have no less than three years experience in the magnitude and character of the work bid.

**Question and Answers:**

Q1) We noticed that the District is requiring 1 mil plus 3 mil aggregate for GL. After speaking with our broker, the standard in the insurance industry is 2 mil aggregate. Could your requirement be adjusted to the 2 mil aggregate for this job?

**A1) Yes, the District will reduce the 3 Million aggregate to 2 million aggregate.**

**Sample Contract Page 27, Section 5, Insurance Requirements, Paragraph (a) change to read as follows:**

(a) Comprehensive Bodily Injury and Property Damage Liability Insurance for Combined Single Limit Bodily Injury and/or Property Damage Liability of not less

than \$1,000,000 each occurrence and ~~\$3,000,000~~ **\$2,000,000** aggregate. The policy(ies) so secured and maintained shall include coverage for Contractual or Assumed Liability, Contractors Protective (Contingency) Liability, Products Liability or Completed Operations, Hazardous Materials (required when the Contract involves removal of these materials), and Owned, Hired, and Non-Owned Automobiles Insurance; and shall be endorsed to the name of the Santa Maria-Bonita School District, its Board and all other indemnitees described in Article 54 of the General Conditions as additional insured and shall provide specifically that any insurance carried by the District which may be applicable to any claim or loss shall be deemed excess and the Contractor's insurance primary despite any conflicting provisions in the Contractor's policy to the contrary. Coverage shall be maintained with no self-insured retention unless the District agrees otherwise in writing.
