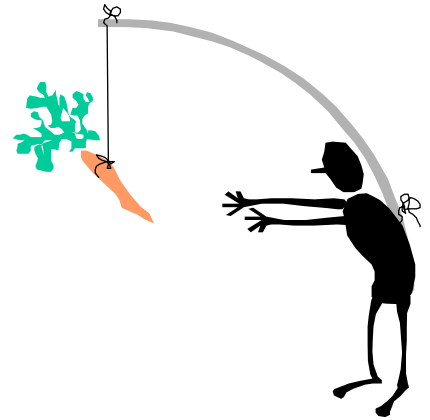


WHEN YOU WRITE A **DESCRIPTION** BE SURE TO:

- Start with a high interest beginning that grabs the reader's attention and tells what the description is about



- Make crisp and vivid descriptions using sensory language

- Imagery lets the reader visualize how something looks, sounds, smells, tastes, and feels



- Provide details in a meaningful order. Details can be in time order, in spatial order, or order of importance.
- Use complete sentences.
- Conclude the description in a satisfying manner.
