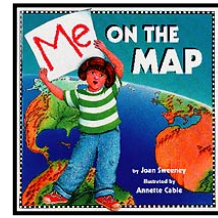


Me on the Map

Narrator: Have you ever wondered where in the world you were? One little girl did and she drew some maps. See how she found her place.

Girl: This is me. This is me in my room. This is a map of my room.

Narrator: So the girl drew herself in her room.

Girl: This is my house. This is my house on my street.

Narrator: Then the girl drew a map of her house and her street.

Girl: This is my town. This map shows my street on the map of my town.

Narrator: Next the girl drew her town and put her street on the map of her town.

Girl: My town is in my state. My state is in my country. My country is the United States of America.

Narrator: So the girl drew her state. Then she drew a map showing her state in the United States of America.

Girl: My country is in the world. Here is my world. It is called Earth. Earth looks like a giant ball. If I could make it flat it would look like this map.

Narrator: The girl drew her country on a map of the world.

Girl: Now let me show you how I find my special place on the map.

Narrator: So the girl looked at the map of the world. She found her country and then her state. Next, she found her town and then her street. Then she found her house on her street.

Girl: In my house I find my room. In my room, I find me! Just think! Everybody has their own special place on the map!
