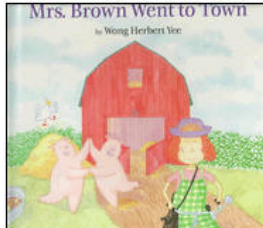

Predict/Infer

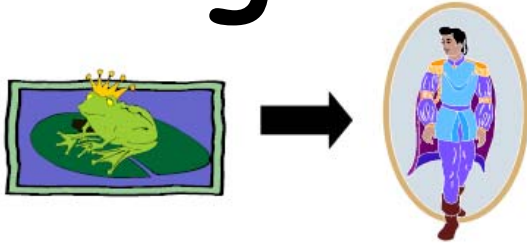
to use what we have read and what we know (schema) to learn more than the author tells us.
