Noun Type	Examples
<p><b>Common Noun/Singular Noun</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Names any one person, place, or thing</li></ul>	dolphin bird book
<p><b>Proper Noun</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Names a particular person, place, or thing. Important words in a proper noun begin with a capital letter.</li></ul>	Robert Fourth of July Mexico
<p><b>Plural Noun</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Names more than one person, place, or thing.<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Plural nouns are formed by adding <i>s</i> to the end of most nouns; adding <i>es</i> to the end of nouns ending in <i>s, x, ch, or sh</i>; or for words ending in a consonant and <i>y</i>, change the <i>y</i> to an <i>i</i> and add <i>es</i>.</li></ul></li></ul>	oceans books babies foxes bushes
<p><b>Special Plural Nouns</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Some nouns form the plural in special ways.</li></ul>	mice feet women
