

HELPING VERBS

A verb sometimes needs help to show past tense.

- **has** and **have** are called helping verbs
- Use **has** with a **singular noun** in the subject and with *he*, *she*, or *it*.

Father has talked to my teacher.

She has finished her lunch.

It has happened over and over again.

- Use **have** with a **plural noun** and with *I*, *you*, *we*, or *they*.

The **birds have** arrived at the mission.

They have launched the rocket.

People have studied the moon and stars.
